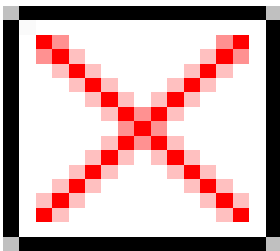




## **FSSAI appoints new members for scientific panels**
